BA (Hons) Business Management

BA (Hons) Business Management is a Work-Based Distance Learning (WBDL) degree which aims to bridge the gap between learning at work and learning at university.

The programme takes into account the high level of skills and learning which are demonstrated every day in the workplace and provides a degree framework to support and accredit this learning.

The BA (Hons) Business Management degree is open to all suitably qualified employees.

Underpinned by extensive research and development, this degree programme provides formal accreditation of approved prior learning and experience against the first two years of a full degree.

Students undertake a final year of study comprising of five core modules and one optional module, graduating with a BA (Hons) in Business Management.

How You Are Assessed

The assessments are designed to address the learning outcomes of all individual modules, utilising a range of assessment methods including essays, portfolios, reflective logs and reports. There are opportunities for formative feedback to aid learning and prepare students for submission of assessments on an on-going basis throughout the programme.

When and Where

Following successful application students will be contacted via email regarding formal enrolment.

The duration of the programme spans a period of two years, and varies according to the individual's personal circumstances, accredited experience, previous learning and work commitments. Programme delivery takes place at a place and pace that suits you.

Students can commence the programme at our 3 intake points throughout the year February, May or October.

Fees

The fees for 2023/2024 academic year entry are \pounds 4,050 for two years, and is payable upfront to the University of Lincoln, UK. (Valid until 31 August 2024).
